Introduction: **PROTIBANDHI SHISHU SHIEKKHA O PARICHARJA SAMITY (PROSHIPS)** is a Non Profit, Non Political and Non-government voluntary organization. PROSHIPS working for Development of the Person with Disabilities. PROSHIPS were established in December 1999 with the initiate of group of young, educated, dedicated professional and social workers.

Goal of Organization

PROSHIPS Goal is to improve the ultimate socio-economic and cultural condition of the community through the development of the most disadvantaged, vulnerable people, women, children and the people with disabilities to ensure their equal rights and opportunities for participation in the mainstream development.

Vision of the Organization

PROSHIPS has been working with the vision to promote development programs in the community to improve the overall socio-economic and cultural condition of the disable , most disadvantaged children , adolescent, of the community. Special emphasis is given on preventing disability, ensuring maternal child health, adolescent family life education and reproductive health education preventing HIV, restoration of child/ human rights and human resource development. PROSHIPS have been trying to implement action programs with the active involvement and participation of the community people. PROSHIPS aspire for a suppression free society with prosperity, peace and equity where all people could get proper opportunity and equal rights to develop.

Brief History of the Organization

Mr.Rafiqul Islam had been works in since 1987 as a teacher of the Deaf Children for speech and language development and Mrs.Begum Rokeya Sarder associated herself with the same profession. (Presently work as Project Coordinator of Proships) When we went to our village on any excursion, occasion of any festival, Parents of many disable children desired meeting with us to have counseling for their rehabilitation measure. We are accordingly provided them with support /cooperation but it was very small scaled due to our limitation. In this way as we are empathetically carry out them and we came to striving conscience to insure rights and opportunities of those disable children. Begum Rokeya Sarder motivation their family member about formation of organization in December 16th ,1998 and to take steps to run works in this respect.

Legal Status of Organization.

Proships is registered with Directorate of social services, Govt. of Bangladesh No- Ja00452 Date 09.06.1999 and it also registered NGO affairs bureau for foreign donation received, Registration No: 1730 Date -14.08.2002.

PROSHIPS has got the recognition of its relentless efforts for enlistment of the disabled people and got the membership of National forum of Organization Working with the Disabled (**NFOWD**) ,Member organization of Association of Development agencies in Bangladesh(**ADAB**) and Jamalpur NGO Forum , Jamalpur Cluster Working Group Member of against **GBV-CP**, Partner NGO of Bangladesh National Social Welfare Council (**BNSWC**) and National Foundation of Development of Disabled person(**NFDDP/JPUF**) Ministry of Social welfare, Government of Bangladesh. It is also member organization of Centre for Disability in Development (**CDD**) and Bangladesh Shishu Adhiker Forum (**BSAF**)

Objectives of the Organization:

PROSHIPS has been striving for achieving the ultimate goal through the following objectives:

- Implement programs to promote health, education and socio-economic development of the most disadvantaged, vulnerable groups and the disabled people;
- Undertake programs for prevention of disability in the community;
- Promote training and educational programs for prevention of disability and rehabilitation of the disabled people in the community;
- Provide educational support and stipend to the talented disabled children and students;
- Conduct baseline survey for identification of the disabled persons and to find out the prevalence rate as well as common causes of disability in the community;
- Advocacy and lobbying with the policy makers, local authority and the elite groups to restore the rights of the disabled children and persons;
- Prepare and collect IEC materials on the basic facts of disability, disability prevention & intervention and disseminate the information among relevant groups;
- Exchange and sharing of experiences of intervention with the other NGOs and parties involved in disability activities;
- Create benevolent fund for the welfare of the disabled children and persons;
- Promote IGAs for economic self-reliance of the disabled persons or the families of the disabled persons in the community;
- Establish effective coordination mechanism between the national and international donor/support agencies and the agencies involved in disability movement;
- Promote programs for integrating the disabled persons in to mainstream development of the community;
- Publication of newsletters to disseminate information on the day-to-day matters of the disabled persons and issues related to their development.
- Promote Awareness raising and Provide emergency relief to the PWDS and CWDs and their families any disaster / catastrophes.

Management of the Organization:

The Executive committee is the responsible tier for implementation of the organizational decisions taken by the general members. The Member Secretary, on behalf of the Executive committee takes over all responsibility of executing the decisions of EC and the general Body. The EC regularly /Quarterly verifies all organizational activities and the role of Member Secretary or Chief Executive in the executive committee meetings. The Chief executive would be the overall responsible person of all activities of the organization .He/She would be accountable to the Executive committee of the organization regarding the implementation of the activities.

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE OF PROSHIPS

PROSHIPS has got a three tier organizational structure. Those are --The General Body, The Executive Committee. The Advisory Committee PROSHIPS comprise a 29 member's General body and 9 members Executive Committee (EC). The Executive Committee is elected for a two-year term by the general body in every alternative annual general meeting. The executive committee is solely responsible for all the activities of the organization. The Executive Committee selects an Advisory Committee comprising members, including the persons with varied expertise and knowledge in the relevant field, dedicated community organizers, local elites, members of the local authority and most popular and acceptable personalities of the community. Members of this Advisory Committee would contribute to PROSHIPS for its proper implementation of programs and survival.

The General Secretary is carrying out the responsibilities of program implementation, all administrative and support services of the PROSHIPS secretariat. The General Secretary of the organization is working as the ex-officio Member Secretary and the Executive Director of PROSHIPS Secretariat. The Executive Director is responsible for day-to-day activities of the organization. The staff members provide their every support to the Executive Director and perform their activities with full responsibility. A well-motivated and well-coordinated team of staff is making their endeavors to contribute to the mainstream development of the community. Performances of all the staff members are evaluated systematically and periodically.

Major learning

Challenges : Treatment support/ advance treatment referral support is not available into the locally govt. hospital/ clinic on Disabilities issues. Secondary stakeholder (School Teacher, others govt staff) does not wants to take part without high official permission on disability issues. Fund Constraint is our main challenge

Program Impacts on Poverty Reduction.

The project activities have made a significant change in the community of the project areas. Now most people of this locality have almost known the rights of the CWDs. The government officials are providing govt. benefits and the transport authorities are ensuring separate seats and half rent for the CWDs and the PWDs. School managements are enrolling the CWDs in primary schools willingly. They also providing stipend to Children with Disabilities student for ensuring education .The hospitals and clinics are providing free health services and making sure the first service for the CWDs. These are direct impact on poverty reduction in the beneficiaries.

PRIMARY HEALTH CARE PROGRAM

In our country most of the NGO are working in this field of disability and services are based on institutionally and situated in urban area. As more than 80% of our population living in rural areas the same portion of Disable people is also living in the rural areas and these rural disable people have no access to the existing services.

Protibandhi Shishu Shiekkha O Paricharja Samity- PROSHIPS carried out a series program to address its integrated prevention and rehabilitation activities. Proships fully compiled the required therapy services, preventative and rehabilitation services and facilitated to the children with Disabilities and their mobility, and accessibility will be increased through the utilization of assistive devices in the community. They will be contribute to improve the over all prevailing situation. Organization have taken action on capacity building to Parents and caregivers of the CWDs and YWDs for management of Menstruation Hygienic, orientation on HIV/STD and handle their home provide different service and learning to their children ,

Numbers of 320 Parents and Caregivers of CWDs are received capacity building training and numbers of 90 Parents of Cerebral palsy Children of our working areas. Health services program supported Centre for Disability in Development (CDD) ,Global Giving Foundation , Jatio Protibandhi Unnayan Foundation (JPUF) Bangladesh National Social Welfare Council (BNSWC) Ministry of of Social welfare Govt.of Bangladesh.

Integrated Prevention and rehabilitation Measures Activities.

Providing Centre based therapeutically services.

PROSHIPS has been carrying out its programs to enable the disable children of the community to be self-reliant and independent as much as it possible. By this time PROSHIPS has also got remarkable successes in this regard. During the reporting Period 107 CWDs were provided with Centre based primary rehabilitation therapy by the CHDRP and CRT of Proships with in Dewangonj and Islampur working Areas. Professional Workers Provided Primary rehabilitation therapy services once a week for each of the Children with Disabilities at his /her home. They provide not only therapy services to the Beneficiaries but also train his/her Principal care givers So that they can keep up continuation of the therapy activities of his or her Children on the other six days of the week. This approach has been proved effective and less expensive.

Under the services of PRT the disable Child given training of ADL /activities of Daily Living .They learn train the Children and Parents how to eat, dress, bath, move and clean themselves without others help or assistance Principal caregivers and Parents can play significant roles towards success and contribution of this program This programs includes following services for Physically Disable: Regular Physiotherapy, Speech training

ADL teaching on dressing and Undressing, Washing of face and teeth, Bathing , wearing and un-wearing shoes, Playing drawing school homework etc. These program supported by Global Giving Foundation and JPUF under Social welfare Ministry of Bangladesh.

Protibandhi Shishu Shiekkha O Paricharja Samity (Proships) Conducted 02(Two) Therapeutically services and health Treatment services running j Area office auditorium & other is at Islampur head office Auditorium under Jamalpur District With Financial support of **Global Giving Foundation USA** and Technical Support By Jamalpur Protibandhi Sheba O shahjja Kendra (**PSOSK**) under Jatio Protibandhi Unnayan Foundation (**JPUF**) and **Bangladesh National Social Welfare Council (BNSWC)** Under Ministry of Social Welfare Govt.of Bangladesh for Autism and others Disable children and also Community People their better oral and dental health care treatment hole days. Numbers of more than two hundred patients received treatment services under both areas.

Organize camp For Improving the Health and Well-Being of PWDs

PROTIBANADHI SHISHU SHIEKKHA O PARICHARJA SAMITY (PROSHIPS), a nonprofit organization dedicated to uplifting persons with disabilities in the Jamalpur district of Bangladesh, During the year 2024 organized a Free Medical Camp for adolescent girls and women with disabilities. This initiative reflects our unwavering commitment to fostering inclusive development and empowering marginalized communities. During the year of 2024 Organization conducted Health services & treatment support camp for the Children with Disabilities and their family members for improved their physical and mental improvement with technical support of Islampur Upazilla Health Complex officer under the Ministry of Health & Family Planning welfare Government of Bangladesh. Doctors provided different Consultative support and treatment support with Medicine. These camp held at Islampur Proships autism and intellectually disable school campus. Total 200 Families of Children with Disabilities received the services from these camp.

Objective and Goal: The primary objective of the camp was to provide accessible healthcare services, address the unique medical needs of adolescent girls and women with disabilities, and promote awareness of reproductive health and hygiene. The overarching goal was to enhance their quality of life by ensuring better health and encouraging self-reliance.

Key Messages: Equal access to healthcare is a fundamental right for all, including persons with disabilities. Education about reproductive health empowers women to make informed decisions. Community support and awareness can eliminate barriers to health services.

Impact of the Activity: The medical camp served over 200 individuals, offering free consultations, medicines, and health education. It addressed critical health concerns, provided actionable advice on reproductive health and hygiene, and fostered a sense of inclusion and dignity among participants. Feedback revealed increased awareness of preventive care and improved confidence in managing personal health.

Organize Eye Camp For Blindness Prevent & Screening Cataracts Patients.

Introduction: PROTIBANADHI SHISHU SHIEKKHA O PARICHARJA SAMITY (PROSHIPS) is a nonprofit, non-governmental voluntary organization dedicated to improving the quality of life for people with disabilities, particularly women, adolescent girls, and children in the Jamalpur district of Bangladesh. As part of its mission to foster community-based development, PROSHIPS prioritizes education, health, and rights restoration for individuals with disabilities. Recently, PROSHIPS, with the technical support of Ispahani Islamia Eye Hospital in Jamalpur, organized an Eye Camp focused on blindness prevention and cataract screening. 

Proships maintain and coordination with the relevant hospitals and other service providing agencies in this period and successfully referral services provide to **76 children with Disabilities** from Non govt/ relevant service providing hospital for the treatment interventions. Organization coworkers are Provide the basic knowledge and aware to her menstruation hygiene and she manages her personnel hygienic and aware about the menstruation Periods to the adolescent girls and women with Disabilities. Due to Families poverty and illiterate they need sanitary hygienic pad for proper manages. Due to family economic condition now she wants donation for buy Hygienic materials .We are provide sanitary pad on the dated 28 April 2022 with

chief guest of Upazilla Nirbahi officer (UNO) Local Govt. representatives. Now she will be enjoying fulfill life independently. She wants monthly Sanitary napkins support during menstruation periods and she wants to help remain healthy, free from infections, more confident positively. We have 100 Adolescent girls and women with Disabilities are main targeted beneficiaries. Most of the Adolescent girls with Disabilities still used old and dirty cloth pieces during periods and these cloths dry in behind and due to lack of menstrual hygiene awareness and difficult access of sanitary pads in rural places. Adolescent girls with disabilities in the rural areas don't management due to their habit and have no knowledge menstrual process and reproductive health. Menstruation is a biological process in women. But this is a big social taboo in our area. She is bound with social and family's restrictions such as:- not touching books, barrier doing home work and outside walking , not publicly discuss about this issue. If we are support to empower and educate Adolescent girls on Personnel hygienic in order to make them physically and emotionally capable to lead a successful life. Enhanced knowledge on menstruation will enlighten them against malpractices during menstruation. We are apologies to donors for support to her and others and we hope and believe comes to us for support adolescents protecting and empower.

Now he is not frustrated his daily life and happy for earning from his grocery shop. Community People are taken necessary good buying from kamal.

Md Rabi Ali is a physical handicapped person He lives in sarder para village under Bahadurabad Union. He is a Wheel Chair user he cannot walking with Standing and Properly. Proships provide a wheel Chair with support from Centre for Disability in Development under the Project of Promotion of Human rights of Person with disabilities in Bangladesh (PHRPBD) . Proships included Govt.Safety Net Program and proships operate Village Saving Loan activity in sarderpara. He is a member of the Disable people Organization and he is taken loan from and operation the shop. Now he is happy for earning and have increasing Dignity in the family



Case Study of Feruja and Her parents are very happy for her earn economical performance



Feruja age 22 years is a physical handicapped woman and comes from poor family. She lives in Nayagram of Bahadurabad union under Dewangonj Upazilla district-Jamalpur, Bangladesh. She is received tailoring training from the organization and after training our organization gave to a sewing machine for carry to job from her house. Now she is earning three to four thousands money from her job in each month and contributes to her family poverty. Her parents are very happy for her economical performance. Her jobs performance is family reducing economic burdens.

Bithi earn Money and towards empower

Bithi is a 18 year old girl who has high ambitions and with dreams to involved and earned money from Income generating activities one day. She has a physical disability affecting both her Legs and feet which limits her mobility. She is using wheel Chair for increasing mobility. She lives in the rural village of Jalmaalpur in Northern Bangladesh. Bithi,s father is died and her mother only earning member of the family .They have a small house which is covered by tin roof. Bithi is one of the beneficiaries our organization and she is most vulnerable from river erosion of her house. Her house is sifted another and she is loosed to her father. After her Father died she always looked down upon, neglected and deprived of most of their basic human rights in the family.

PROSHIPS is Provide skill training on handicraft training and IGAs training to her and given small support with Material for development and she will earn for themselves. Provide the basic knowledge and awareness on reproductive and sexual health. Educate and inform them about Safety measures to avoid social risks and threats. Now Bithi is involved in Handicrafts work in her house and earn little money for her survival



4. Empowerment Program

Empower Program demanded on the Income Generating Activities with group Members of the Promoting and establishing of Human Rights and raising improve empowerment condition of PWDs is one of the important activities . The main objective of this activity is to enrich the skills of the RPC Members so that they could be able to make the environment desirable for the CWDs, could be able to make a disability friendly society, could be aware and could be necessary Initiatives able of CWDs/PWDs. Proships formation of 14 DPO/SHGs with 195 Disable members they are taken own decision for their development Now they are empowered then before and they are capable for advocacy with different stakeholders (Govt official , MP and Political leader etc)

DPOs Initiatives: Proships formation committee with citizen's and Representatives of the up members, Adults CWDs, PWDs, school teachers, local elites and family members of CWDs for the accessibility, promotion of education and rehabilitation opportunities of disabled children in the community . They are taken initiatives and conducted meeting with different issues in Social Development activities for Children With Disabilities(CWDs)& Person with disabilities(PWDs) family in deferent's location / villages of project areas under 9 Unions and 2 Powrosova and its activities on going smoothly and given counseling intervention to parents and care givers of CWDs for their Development and Establishing there accessibility Process

Self Help Group (SHGs)Operation

Social discrimination on Person with disabilities is very common. They are often looked at with over sympathy or neglect. They are left out of social activities and no one usually mix with them. They are mistreated and exploited in all sphere of social life. In most cases are excluded from the normal life. They are relatively invisible in social function and gathering. As a result they become more and more vulnerable disadvantaged. In order to overcome this situation and create awareness different way towards disability and person with disabilities be raised voice



and rights of the PWDs will be promoted in the community and will be aware, motivated and supportive to the development process of person with disabilities. In this connection proships initiating 14 (Fourteen) SHGs formation and operate in the working areas. In each groups consist numbers are 15 PWDs. Total numbers of 194 (One hundred Ninety Four) person with disabilities involved in the Self Help Groups.

Groups member are training received on Leadership Development and advocating for increasing access in to mainstreaming process from CDD. After training they are organized twice /one day meeting within a month and functioning their activities spontaneously

SHGs activity:

- They are discussion in the meeting about problem and need based activity on their rights establishing in the community.
- SHGs members are making decision and they are coordinate and communication with different level for social inclusion.
- They are attend to local level and district level meeting through proships where needed for presenting issues.
- They are advocating for issuing Disability ID Card ,VGF VGD and enrolling Children with disabilities in their local school.

Advocacy Group Apex Body Operation



Apex body /Advocacy Group formation with the representatives of Self Help Group Members .Numbers of 2 representatives included in the Apex body committee by election. Numbers of 20 members are consists apex body committee. Apex body is higher level advocacy group for development of the SHGs members and other Person with Disabilities in the Community. They are always lobby and advocacy with Govt official and Local Govt. official for interest of their members. **Apex Body setting in each month or within two month for their needs based activities and they are taken decision and implementation.**

Babita is Women with Physical handicapped with walking problem who has high ambitions and with dreams to involved and earned money from home base goat farming and Court yard gardening activities one day. She is educated women study in Madrasha and lives in muslim family with her family. She lives in the rural village of Gamaria its part of Dewangonj upazilla under district of Jalmpur in Northern Bangladesh. Her Parents very poor family and she is received goat farming training and Home stead gardening through our organization and She always trying to earn for support her family .Her father is a poor day labor and have a small hut. She is most vulnerable and she always looked down upon, neglected and deprived of most of their basic human rights in the family. She is faces hard core poverty. Last year in September we provide a goat for farming in her house (Picture attached in this report)



In this issues and recovered the Challenges she wants to individually sponsor for increasing her implements development activities – Goat farming or Cow farming (need daily poultry food , Vaccine) ,home stead gardening in house.
